



There are more than 30 Ji-Kabuki preservation organizations in Gifu Prefecture and Gifu is one of the most active regions for Ji-Kabuki in Japan.

People in rural parts of the nation started organizing and holding Kabuki performances by themselves in their hometowns in shrines and stiba-goyas (playhouses). These amateur forms of Kabuki played in rural parts of Japan are called "Ji-Kabuki" in Gifu Prefecture.

There are 9 historical shiba-goyas (playhouses) and many Ji-Kabuki preservation organizations in Gifu. The stories and dance routines from the Edo period (1603-1868) have been cherished and passed down from generation to generation.

This is a rare opportunity on which Ji-Kabuki preservation organizations in Gifu Prefecture all gather together and perform one after another.

\* How to go by bus

Take a bus from the North Bus Terminal No. 10 at JR Gifu Station or the C-Stand at Meitetsu Gifu Bus Terminal. You have the option of three buses: the "K49 Kideji housing complex line", the "K50 Nagara Yatsushiro park" or the "K55 Awarorashi 5". Get off at the "Gifu Memorial Center main gate" stop and walk south for about 1 minute.

■From Nagoya

JR Nagoya station → JR Gifu station (Take the JR Tokaido Line, 18 minutes by New Rapid)

■From Chubu Central International Airport (Central Japan International Airport)

Central Japan International Airport station → (via Meitetsu Nagoya station) → Meitetsu Gifu station

(1 hour and 20 minutes by Express)

(1 hour by uSky Ltd. Express.)

## How to apply · how to view

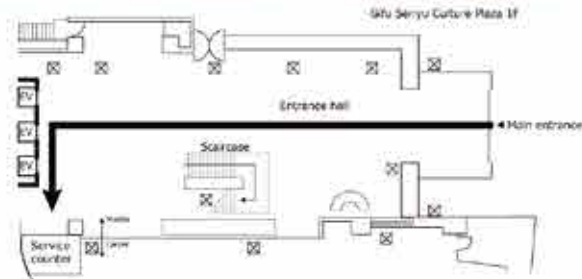
① If you wish to view, click "distributing" button in the performance schedule and proceed to apply.  
 You will get an e-mail from: [info@jkabuki-gifu.com](mailto:info@jkabuki-gifu.com).

② On the day of the performance, please come to the service counter on the first floor at Gifu Seiryu Bunka Plaza 20 minutes before the performance starts and receive your ticket. Please show the e-mail you received either on your screen or on paper you printed out.

③ Please come to the reception at Nagaragawa hall on the second floor 15 minutes before the performance starts and show your reserved ticket.

\* If you do not arrive on time, you may not be able to enter.

④ The seating is non-reserved. If there is a particular seat you wish to sit in, we recommend that you come early.
